





There's a unique aromatic profile to this grape that's hard to pin down, but, at least in this bottling, runs from makrut-lime leaf and green-apple extract to sansho pepper and white pepper. There's a fascinatingly flinty kick to the nose of this bottling, reminiscent of mineral-driven Sancerre, and then come waves of green apple and lime.
